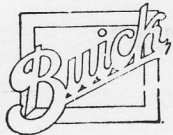

BOWLING IN KOKOMO 1863 TO 1938

Bowling entered into the lives of the people of Kokomo back when the town was a mere village and long before they ever realized that it would grow to such an extent that at some day more people would be bowling on alleys in the city than lived in the entire village at that time.

Bowling made its first appearance during the Civil War days when a man by the name of Nat McCool placed a single alley on the south side of the public square about where Rapp's Clothing store now stands. Phil Mattix, a brother of the late J. C. Mattix, was a pin boy in this original establishment.

The next alley to make its entry was placed on the north side of the square by Dick Shepherd in the early 1870's where the Big Shoe Store is now located. At that time this lot was vacant and this single alley was placed there with a wood shed built over it for protection.

Next J. C. Mattix in 1876 put up a similar structure on the west side of the square where the Colonial Theater is located. He operated in this structure until 1886. At this time Mr. Mattix built a new building on this site to house his alleys and operated there until 1896 when he sold to Otto Kollmar.

In those earlier days of bowling there were no holes in the ball and the bowler would straddle the alley and roll the ball with both hands. In doing so, he would fall forward onto the alley on his stomach. This is greatly in contrast to the graceful rhythmic delivery used today.

Bowling kept pace with the town's growth and moved from one location to another from these early days until now, Charlie Duke ran a set of alleys in the old Opera House. There was a bowling establishment on Main street at one time. The Y. M. C. A. operated a set of alleys for years under the management of Mr. J. C. Mattix. Another establishment lasted for a while on West Mulberry street in the basement under the Paramount Theater and also in the Menigs Pool Room on East Mulberry street.

The present set of alleys that form the six alleys on the Main floor of the Kokomo Recreation Incorporated came from the former establishment on Buckeye street over the Hamilton-Harris offices. William Cooper and a partner put these alleys in new. Sam Phillips and Harry Schneiderman purchased them at a later date. These men changed their location to the Odd Fellows Building in the summer of 1933. In 1935 they formed a corporation and placed six additional alleys in the basement of the Odd Fellows Building. This equipment was modernized during the past summer and is now one of the nicest establishments in the state.

During the past summer Forrest Evans has installed eight 20th Century Alleys in the location of the Evans & Son Wall Paper Store. Frosty has done himself proud by doing everything possible to make his new place one of the outstanding bowling establishments in this part of the country.

The present Kokomo Bowling Association was formed about twenty years ago with Harry O. Davis as secretary. It has continued through these years and grown until this year the number of teams both men and women will probable reach the 220 mark.

Bowling in Kokomo has advanced to where it is readily becoming an important part of the social and recreational development of the city. Women are becoming increasingly enthusiastic about the game and this association of the women and children to this wonderful game of American Ten Pins has brought about great strides in this ancient game of bowling in Kokomo.
